


GENERAL:

1. This dummy tank was discovered near a German airport in the Ninth U. S. Army area. It was positioned in an open field, as though it had just been driven out of a brush lined lane leading from the Flak position.

2. The tank was made of wooden slats on a wood frame and was mounted on four metal wheels. The only attempt at camouflage was by the scanty application of various colored paint. It had drawn very little small arms fire, and no artillery fire or bombing.
