1. GERERALA

A wooden durmy tank resembling the Russian T34 tank has been encountered in the Rinth U. S. Army area. The tank was found at a German army school and had apparently been used as a mobile target for training with the Panserfaust. Several training models of the Panserfaust were found at the same location.copy

2. DESCRIPTION:

The dummy tank is constructed of wood strips wan is supported and propelled by a Remault light armoved carrier located in the front section of the framework (photo 2). The rear section of the framework is supported on two sirplane wheels. The bottom of the front plate is hinged to provide an entrance for the driver and has vision openings cut into it.
